ECLAS focuses on publications of the EU and has also an extensive collection of publications of **international organisations** such as the UN, OECD, World Bank, etc.

The catalogue contains a wealth of books and journals from commercial publishers in all EU languages, the largest part is in French, English and German. One of the strengths of the ECLAS catalogue is the **collection of articles on EU-related matters**, selected by librarians from the most relevant journals.




