EU Bookshop Deep linking guide

The New EU Bookshop — Overview

The EU Bookshop in his new configuration went online on February 2010. It provides direct access to around 150 000 PDF files dating back to 1952 including an order facility via credit card payment for free and priced publications. A specific login facility for EU Officials (for the Commission via web login and password) allows a free copy of priced publications for duty purposes, based on the signature of the Head of unit. In contrary to the previous version, no distinction between current production and the digital archive exists any more.

Deep linking is making a hyperlink pointing to a specific page on EU Bookshop. Below you will find a short description on how to link directly to:

- 1. a specific title in EU Bookshop,
- 2. a specific theme,
- 3. all publications of a specific author service or
- 4. mapping between the previous EU Bookshop PubID and the catalogue number
- 5. Annexes: codes tables

1. How to link to a specific publication

The deep link should have the following format:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:NOTICE:<catalogue number>:<navigation language>

The deep link is composed of the first 9 characters of the catalogue number, followed by the 2 characters of the navigation language you want for the information display.

For example, for displaying the details related to publication KA7007020 in the navigation language English, the link will look as follows:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:NOTICE:KA7007020:EN

You can also add the language code to the 9 characters of the catalogue number:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:NOTICE:KA7007020EN:EN

Please note that due to the strictly language based architecture of the EU Bookshop, the display of the publication language is coupled with the navigation language chosen, with fallback to EN.

Therefore, if no navigation language encoding is applied, EU Bookshop will choose EN by default:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:NOTICE:KA7007020

If you implement such links on your website engine or in-house application, we recommend to dynamically link to the current navigation language of the user. It will be of course more user friendly to keep the same browsing language when going from your website to the related EU Bookshop pages.



2. How to link to a specific theme

The link is based on the theme code, as defined in the Publications Office's thematic classification, and should have the following format:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:THEME:<theme code>:<navigation language>

The deep link in the following example refers to the list of all publications on the theme 'Fisheries policy' (theme code H03):

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:THEME:H03:EN

3. How to link to a specific author service

The link is based on the author service code and should have the following format:

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:AUTHOR:<author code>:<navigation language>

The deep link in the following example refers to the list of all publications of the European Commission's Directorate-General for the Environment (author code ENV):

http://bookshop.europa.eu/uri?target=EUB:AUTHOR:ENV:EN

4. Mapping between the previous EU Bookshop PubID and the catalogue number

The previous EU Bookshop engine used unfortunately a proprietary identification instead of the catalogue number called PublD. As the new EU Bookshop uses the final catalogue number format, a mapping will have to be applied for all those who used the PublD.

A text mapping the previous EU Bookshop PubID and the catalogue number is provided separately.
