### European Governance

- the duty of the EU to inform (and to listen)

- information needs to be 'clear, objective, comprehensive, relevant and easy to find'
- Decision-makers must: listen better, explain better and connect with citizens (European Commissioner Margot Wallström's web blog, 17 June 2005)

#### Information and communication policy
